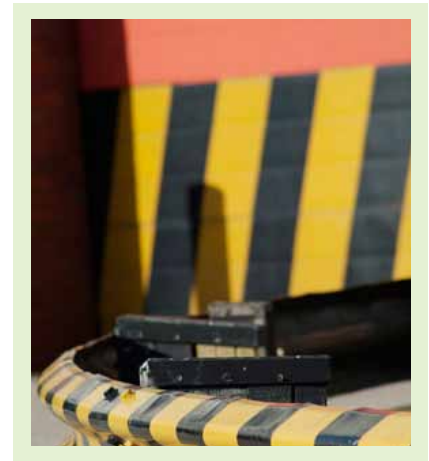

# Lerwick Port



Lerwick Harbour is a modern port, uniquely positioned to support a range of industries onshore and offshore in the northern sea and Atlantic. The port has two entrances and is open to shipping in all weathers.

The Lerwick Port Authority has interests in the long-term future of fishing which has been demonstrated not only by aspects of its capital programme, but also its investment portfolio, the port continues to offer:

- A major fishing port
- A leading support centre for the offshore oil and gas and decommissioning industries.
- A freight facility for general & specialist cargo.
- A popular port-of-call for cruise ships and yachts.



Oil related business plays a major part in the ports services, from provision of marine support to decommissioning activity. Peterson SBS upgraded the extensive facilities already in place at Greenhead in 2006 to include a licensed decommissioning pad and controlled discharge area. Adding to this, the Lerwick Port Authority invested almost £0.5M in additional quay strengthening during 2006 and 2007 to accommodate and support decommissioning projects.



# Lerwick Facilities

Greenhead Base - The base has two quaysides, north and south, made of reinforced concrete slab construction supported by tubular steel piles, driven to the bedrock.

Both quaysides are naturally sheltered and have sea access via a wide channel with a minimum water depth of 9 metres CD enabling shipping access in all weathers 24 hours a day.

**South Quay is ~390m long, North Quay is ~ 220m long.**

**Water depths of up to -9m ACD minimum draft are available alongside Greenhead South Quay Berths.**

**There is no restriction on Air Draft in Lerwick Port**



## Tide and Wave

The quaysides are constructed to a height approximately 3.4m above chart datum. The tidal range in Lerwick is approx. 2m on average with Mean High Water Springs at +2.2m CD and Mean Low Water Springs at +0.5CD.

The maximum significant wave height within the turning basin has been assessed as less than 0.7m.



## Decommissioning

Peterson SBS are a leader when it comes to undertaking and supporting decommissioning projects in the North Sea with continuing development of infrastructure at Lerwick Harbour.

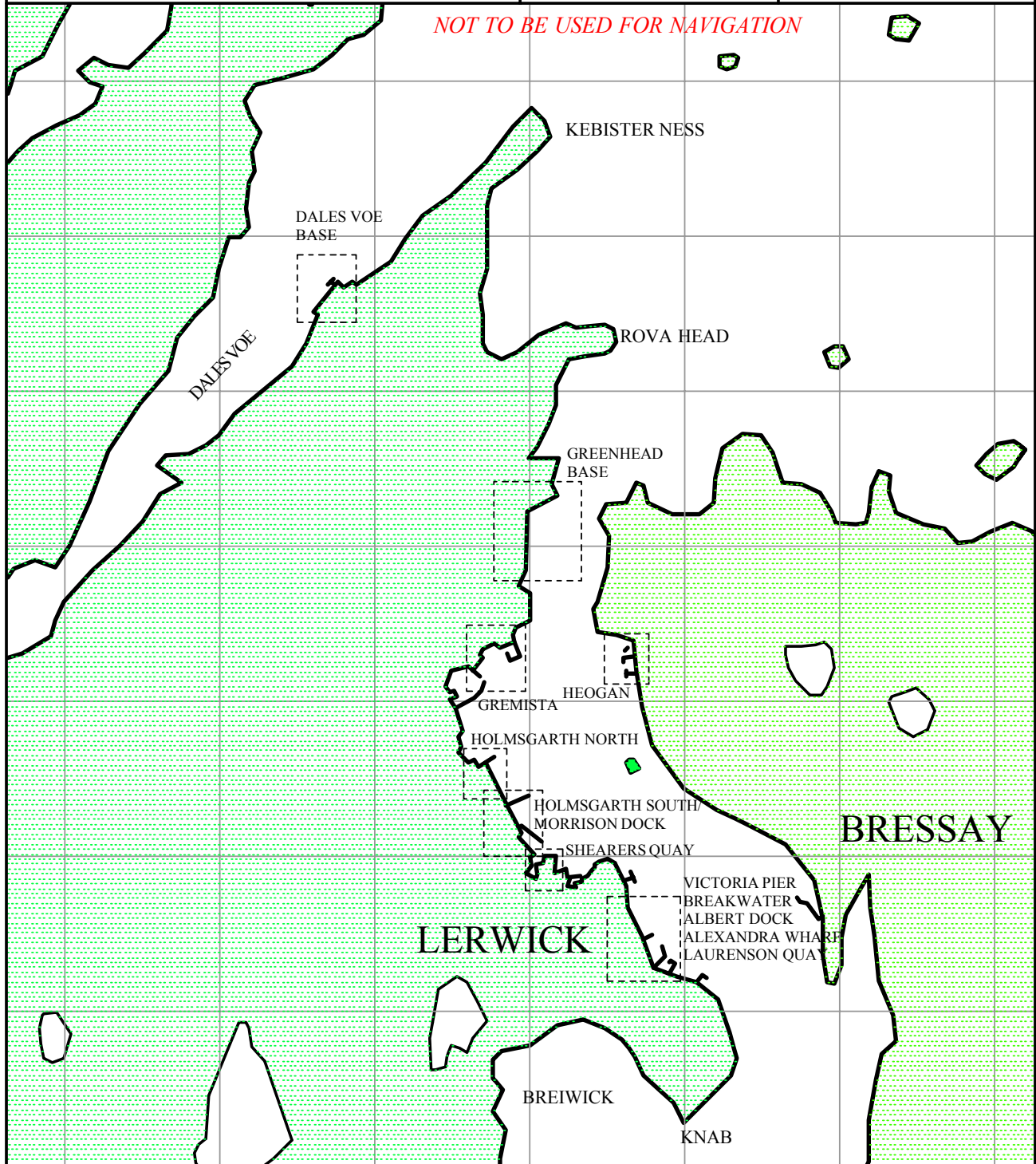
